Water- A Life Source for All

All Grades | \$5 per person | 30 Students Max

Students will learn about the importance of water and how it is a necessity for Pueblo People. Through an additional presentation, they will describe the connection between culture and land. Along with identifying human and community uses of water. They will take part in a hands-on classroom activity, where they will be working with seeds.

This activity aligns to New Mexico State Standards.



My Culture Helps me

All Grades | \$5 Per Person | 30 Students Max

Students will focus on identifying how family and community collectively build cultural identity. Students will learn how cultural traditions of Pueblo people have been passed down from one generation to the next. Students will participate in an open dialogue explaining how cultural values and traditions from the past impact present time, through a hands-on demonstration of tortilla making.

Pueblo Resources & Symbolism

All Grades | \$5 Per Person | 30 Students Max

Students will learn about the natural resources utilized by Pueblo people. Through an additional presentation, they will learn about the symbolism used in pottery and other art forms. Students will describe the connection between culture and land. They will take part in a hands-on activity, where they will be creating their own piece of pottery and design.
