Food and Community

All Grades | \$5 per person | 30 Students Max

Students will gain knowledge as to why community is foundational to a Pueblo way of life. They will gain and demonstrate understanding of how food is central to the community and identity of Pueblo People. Students will be able to increase their knowledge of Feast Days and the significant role they play. Students will engage in an interactive classroom activity to enhance community connection.

This activity aligns to New Mexico State Standards.



Pueblo Places

All Grades | \$5 per person | 30 Students Max

Students will identify ways in which Pueblo People exemplify and perpetuate the Creator's Gift of community in daily life and through cultural traditions. They will analyze photographs and videos of ancestral and present Pueblo places and spaces to increase their understanding of how community is central to Pueblo way of being. Students participate in a hands-on classroom activity, where they will be working with clay.

This activity aligns to New Mexico State Standards.



Water- A Life Source for All

All Grades | \$5 per person | 30 Students Max

Students will learn about the importance of water and how it is a necessity for Pueblo People. Through an additional presentation, they will describe the connection between culture and land. Along with identifying human and community uses of water. They will take part in a hands-on classroom activity, where they will be working with seeds.

This activity aligns to New Mexico State Standards.

Exploring Cultural Identity

All Grades | \$5 per person | 30 Students Max

Students will gain an in-depth understanding of the resilient history Pueblo People have and the monumental impact it continues to serve our Pueblo communities. They will be able to create ways to perpetuate their language, culture and traditions. Along with exploring and articulating individual and collective culture identities through core values. Students will explore concepts about cultural identity through an interactive classroom activity.
